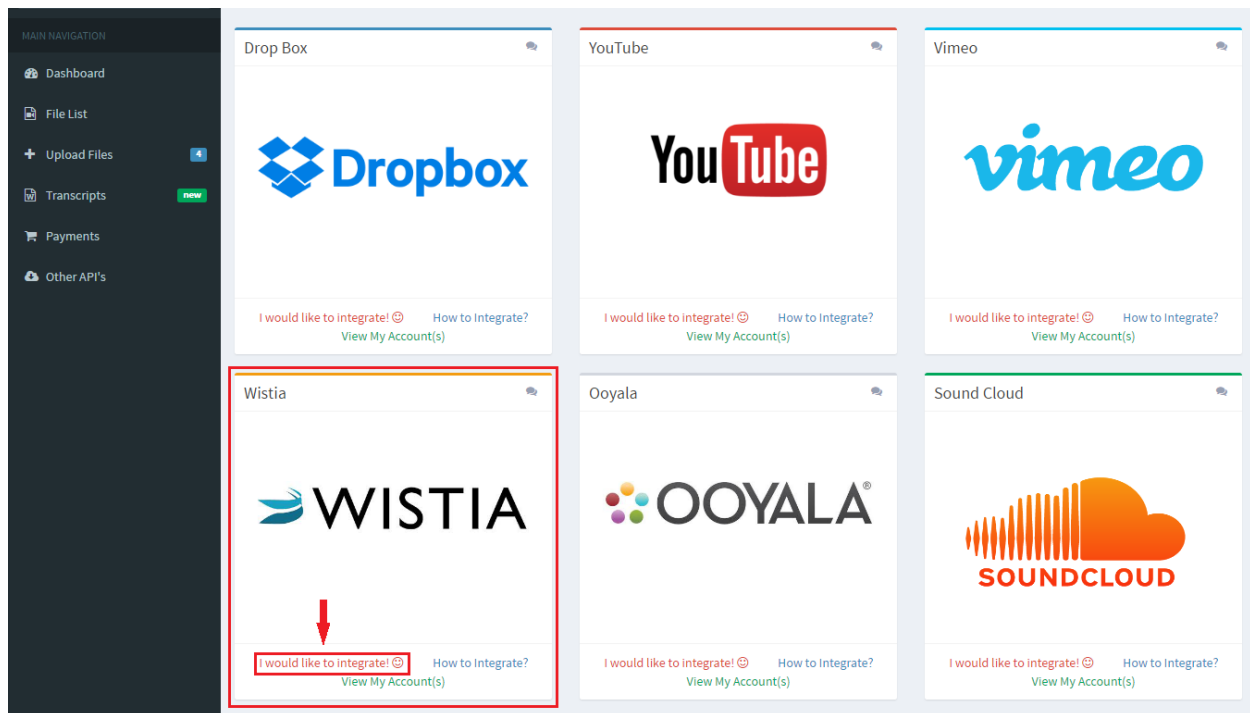


## WISTIA Integration:


WISTIA, a popular video hosting website for businesses is now integrated into iTranscript for your convenience. Now, sync your WISTIA account to your iTranscript account to have your videos transcribed without the need for uploading them on a regular basis.

To sync your WISTIA account follow these quick & simple steps.



**Step 1.** Click on *'I would like to integrate,* ' under the WISTIA logo

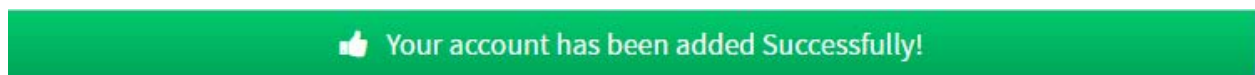
(You will be directed to the *'Login'* page.)

**Step 3.** Click on 'View Account Files'.

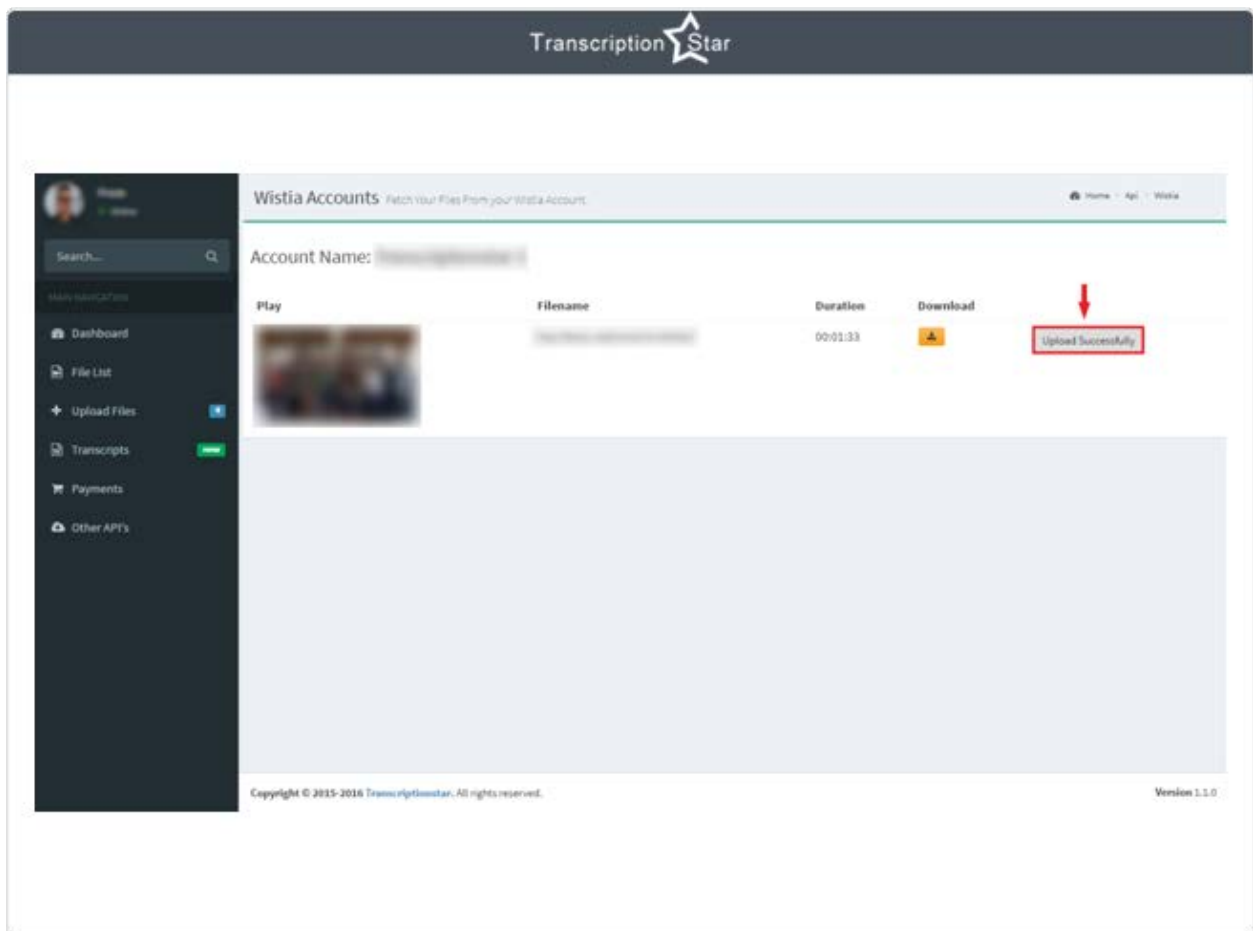
